Step into the 1470s Great Hall – part of the medieval royal palace, where Henry VIII spent his childhood. For a complete contrast, in 1936, eccentric millionaires Stephen and Virginia Courtauld built their magnificent art deco mansion right next to the Great Hall, creating a masterpiece of modern interiors. There is much to explore across the ages of this royal place including the amazing art deco dining room and the Instagram worthy gold-plated bathroom, not forgetting the beautiful gardens with seasonal colours.
